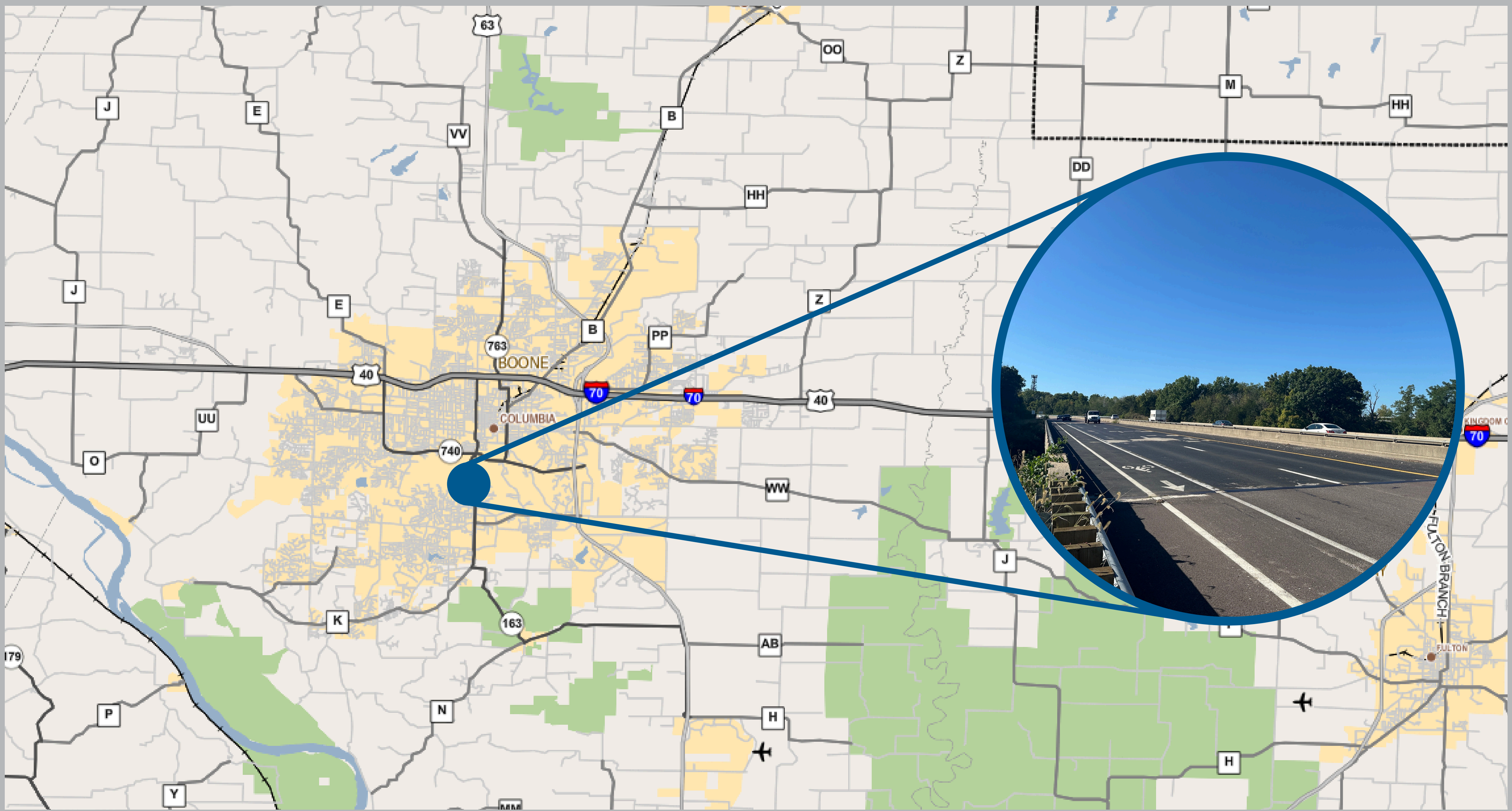


MISSOURI ROUTE 163 BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT OVER HINKSON CREEK



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

The Missouri Route 163 (Providence Road) bridge over Hinkson Creek in Columbia, is scheduled for a replacement of the northbound bridge deck (driving surface) in 2027. Planned improvements include:

- New, smoother driving surface.
- Replacing current railings with new barriers.
- Installing new pavement marking.
- Installing new approach pavement.

Current Project Timeline

- **Dec. 2026:** Contractors submit competitive bids.
- **Jan. 2027:** Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.
- **Feb. 2027:** If awarded in December, earliest contractor may begin work.
- **Dec. 2027:** Anticipated project completion.

Traffic Impacts

Providence Road is expected to remain open during construction with northbound traffic being narrowed to one lane. Traffic will be maintained in both directions by shifting all vehicles onto the southbound lanes, which will carry two lanes of southbound traffic and one lane of northbound traffic.

All lanes of traffic are expected to be open to traffic by mid-August 2027.
