
U.S. ROUTE 63 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS IN NORTHERN BOONE COUNTY



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

U.S. Route 63 at Route CC/Roy Barnes Road and Crofton Hall Road, in northern Boone County, near Sturgeon, are slated for improvement in 2026.

Route CC/Roy Barnes Road improvements include:

- Removing crossover.
- Adding acceleration and deceleration lanes at Route CC and Roy Barnes Rd.
- Installing lighting at the intersection.

Crofton Hall Road improvements include:

- Adding acceleration and deceleration lanes at Crofton Hall Road on southbound U.S. Route 63.
- Old Route 63 will be extended, and two driveways between Crofton Hall Road and Roy Barnes Road will shift their access from U.S. Route 63 to the new, resurfaced extension.

Estimated Cost

• \$3 million including engineering and construction costs, subject to change.

Traffic Impacts

At this time, the roadways are expected to remain open, but motorists will encounter lane closures throughout the construction process. There may be turning restrictions through construction, but access to all businesses and residences will be maintained throughout the project.

Current Project Timeline

- May 2026: Contractors submit competitive bids.
 - June 2026: Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.
 - **2026:** Construction could begin sometime in 2026, but the specific start date will not be determined until after the contract is awarded.
 - Nov. 2027: Anticipated project completion.
