
U.S. ROUTE 63 & ROUTE CC INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS IN BOONE COUNTY



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

The intersection of U.S. Route 63 at Route CC & Roy Barnes Road in Boone County, west of Sturgeon, is slated for improvement in 2026. Improvements include:

- Removing crossover.
- Adding deceleration and acceleration lanes for Route CC and Roy Barnes Rd.
- Installing lighting to the intersection.

Traffic Impacts

At this time, the roadway is expected to remain open, but motorists may encounter lane closures throughout the construction process.

Estimated Cost

• \$3 million including engineering and construction costs, subject to change.



Current Project Timeline

- May 2026: Contractors may submit competitive bids.
- June 2026: Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.
 - 2026: Construction could begin sometime in 2026, but the specific start date will not be determined until after the contract is awarded.
- Nov. 2027: Anticipated project completion.
