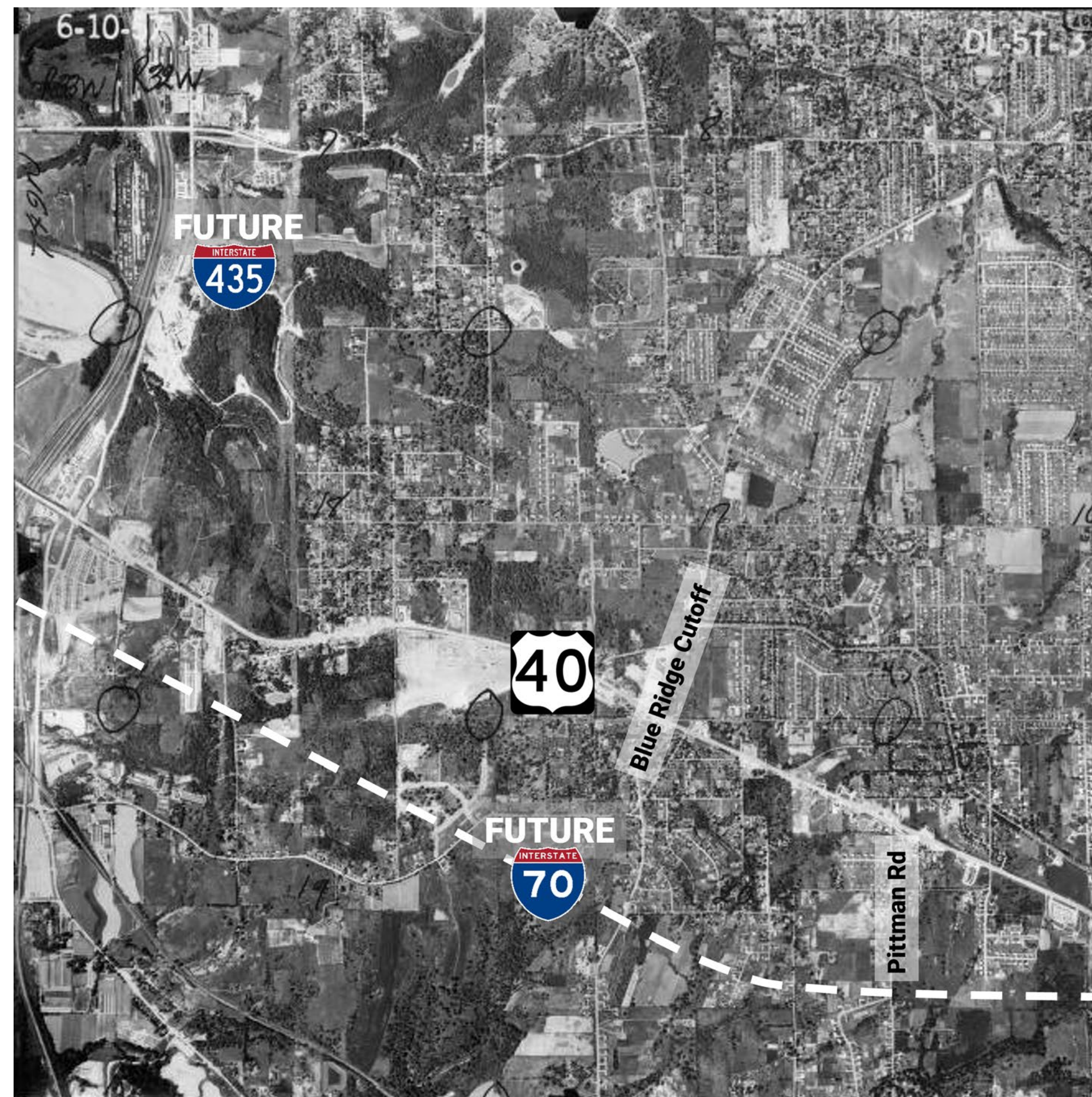
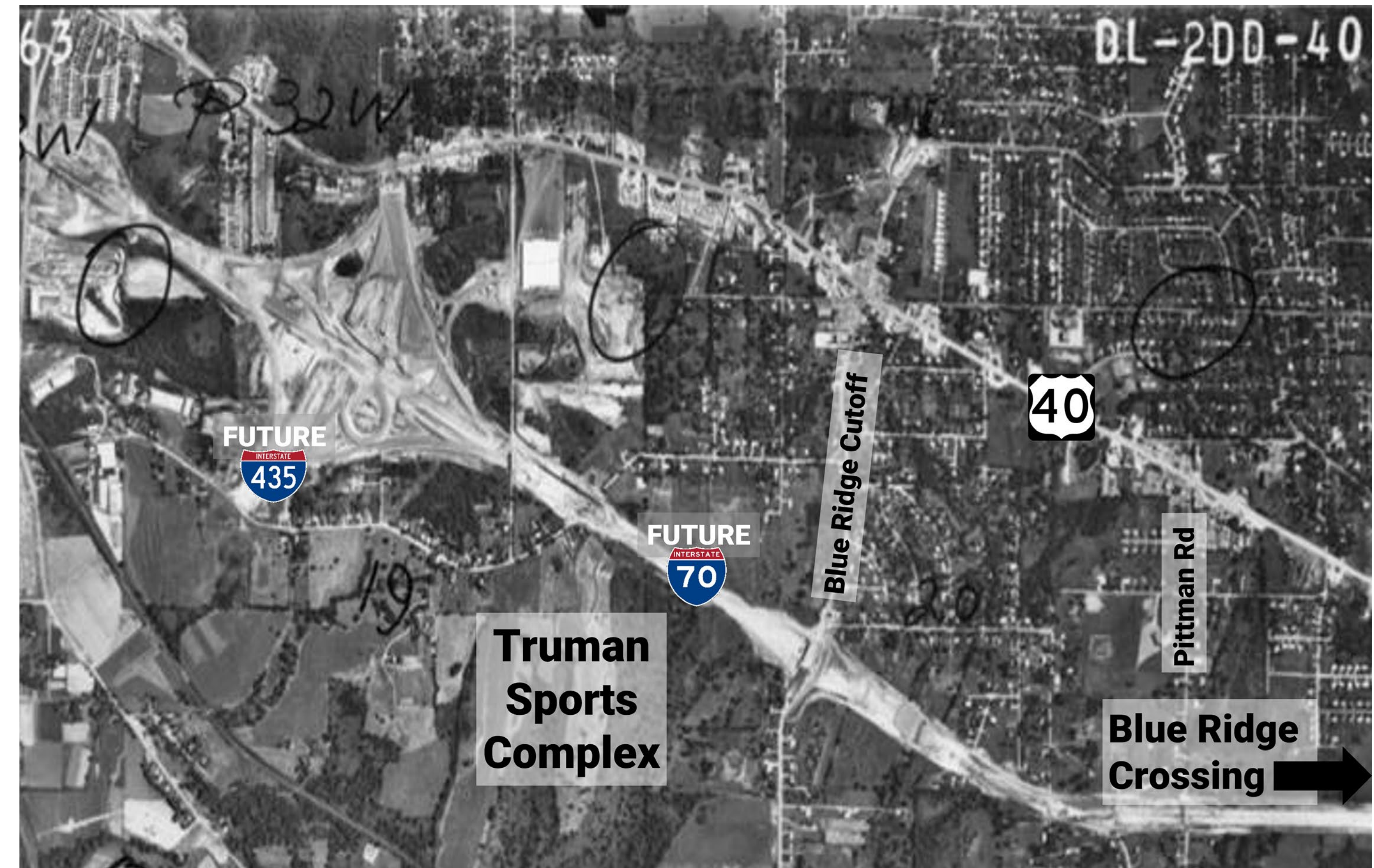


U.S. 40 History



Pre 1957 – I-70 did not exist and US 40 was the main East-West route from Missouri into KC



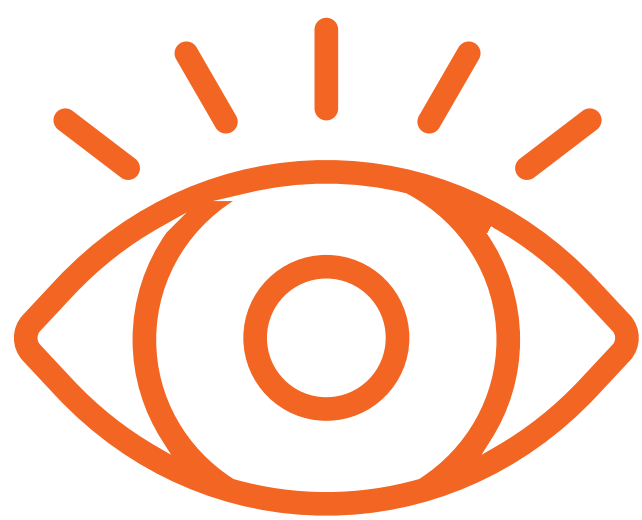
Post 1963 – I-70 built, replacing US 40 as the main East-West route

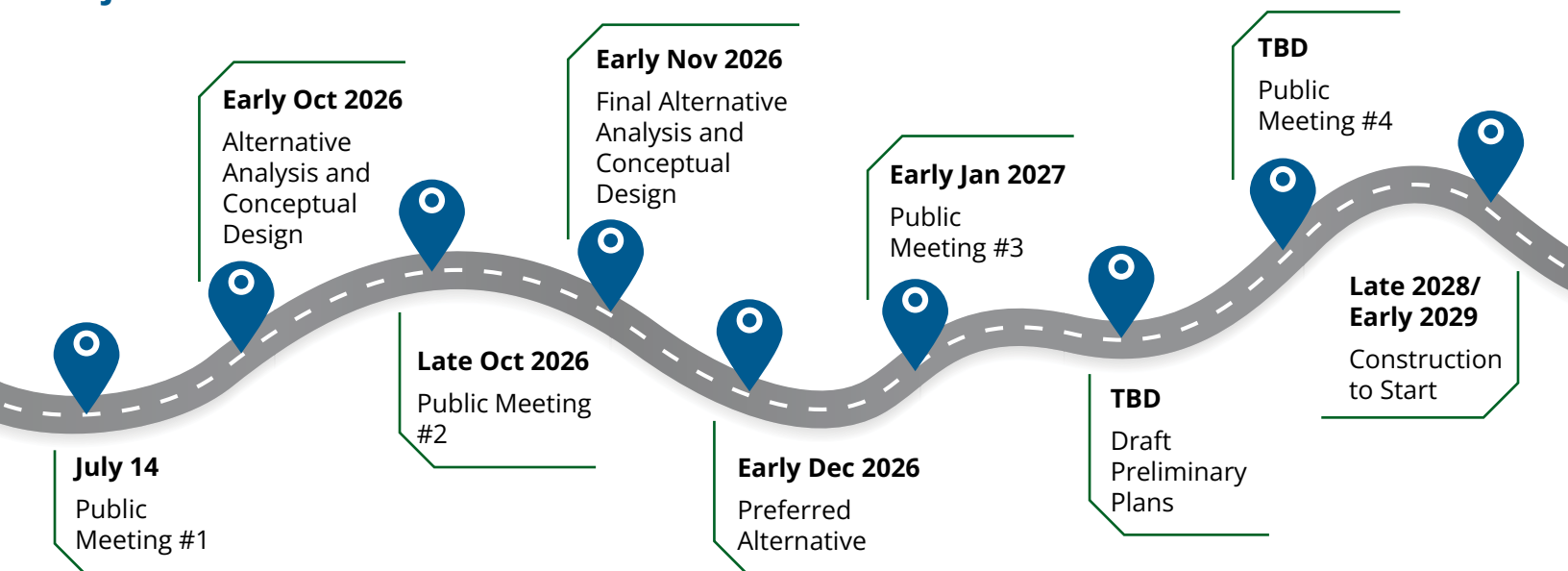
