Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of the online meeting?

The purpose of the online meeting is to provide information on plans to replace the bridge over the Bourbeuse River on Missouri Route T, approximately 1.5 miles south of Route V near Owensville.

Why is this work necessary?

The existing Bourbeuse River Bridge was built in 1958 and is sixty-one years old. The condition of the bridge has reached a point where a bridge replacement is necessary.

How will traffic be affected?

During construction Route T will be closed at the bridge location for up to four and a half months. Signs will alert motorists of the closed road and a detour will be signed during construction. Drivers are asked to seek alternate routes around the construction.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled to be awarded in the summer of 2019, with construction also taking place in 2019.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?

Temporary construction easements will be required for the construction of the bridge.

What will the project cost?

The total construction cost is approximately \$1,818,000.
