Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of online meeting is to provide information on plans to rehab the bridge over Interstate 44 on Route H in Pulaski County. The project is located in St. Robert.

Why is this work necessary?

The existing structure on Route H was damaged when struck by a dump truck in the east bound lanes on Interstate 44.

How will traffic be affected?

The roadway will be closed to the public during working hours of 7 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. for the entire duration of the project.

When will the work take place?

The construction will take up to 10 calendar days between February 10, 2020 and March 31, 2020.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

All work will be done within existing Right of Way.

What will the project cost?

The total project cost is approximately \$286,000.
