## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?**

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans to replace the Grindstone Creek Bridge on Missouri Route 124, west of U.S. Route 63.

### **Why is this work necessary?**

The existing Grindstone Creek Bridge was built in 1932 and is eighty-six years old. The condition of the bridge has reached a point where replacement is necessary.

### **How will traffic be affected?**

The new bridge will be built on new alignment immediately to the south of the existing bridge. Route 124 will remain open during construction of the new bridge until work is necessary to tie the new alignment to the existing roadway. At that time, Route 124 will be closed for a short period of time to complete this final grading and paving work. Alternate routes will be available.

### **When will the work take place?**

The project is scheduled to be awarded in the fall of 2018, with construction taking place in 2019.

### **Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?**

Approximately 1.5 acres of new permanent right of way needs to be acquired from two property owners and approximately 0.4 acres of temporary easements will be necessary from four property owners.

### **What will the project cost?**

The total cost is approximately \$1.0 million.
