## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?**

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on proposed improvements to the U.S. Route 54 and Miller County Route W intersection in Lake Ozark. The proposed construction will improve safety and mobility for motorists in that area.

### **Why is this work necessary?**

The project is necessary to increase the safety of the Route 54 and Route W intersection and reduce traffic accidents. This work will also improve traffic flow through the area.

### **When will the work take place?**

The project is scheduled to be bid in the summer of 2019, with construction tentatively scheduled to start in the fall of 2019. Construction is expected to take two years.

### **Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?**

Yes. We are estimating the project will require the acquisition of 15-25 acres. Based on our current timeline, right of way acquisition plans will be available next summer.

### **What will the project cost?**

We are estimating the construction costs of the project will be \$10-12 million.

### **What is the next step?**

MoDOT will start the design of the preliminary plans, conduct environmental surveys, begin geotechnical investigations and develop proposed intersection types based on the traffic data that has been collected. Another public meeting will be held next spring to provide the opportunity to review the plan development.
