



## Route Y over Cedar Fork Creek Bridge Replacement

**Why is this project needed?** The bridge located on Route Y over Cedar Fork Creek was built in 1948 and needs to be replaced due to age. The travel lanes on Route Y will be widened to 22 feet. The bridge will also be raised to accommodate the flow of Cedar Creek.

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

The traffic plan will be released once MoDOT is closer to construction. The project will take approximately three months. The bridge is located in Franklin County, where Route Y crosses Cedar Creek, an estimated 8 miles north of Highway 50 in Gerald, MO.

### CONSTRUCTION

Construction on the project is set to begin Summer 2024 and will be completed in Fall 2024. The estimated project cost is \$1.5 million. During construction a detour will be in place. A detailed construction schedule will be made available to the public as we get closer to construction.
