Description and Benefit

The Ground Alert System is an innovation that enhances work zone safety by installing an ABLE 2 siren and 100-watt speaker in pilot cars to provide an audible warning for crews on the ground. When the pilot car brings traffic through, the driver activates an electric horn that produces a distinctive sound—alerting workers without startling them like a standard vehicle horn. This system reduces the risk of workers stepping into traffic and prevents injuries caused by sudden reactions to loud noises. It improves situational awareness, streamlines communication, and has been widely appreciated by crews for making daily operations safer and more efficient. Overall, the Ground Alert System is a simple, cost-effective solution that significantly increases safety for any project using pilot cars.
