<u>LINE 2 – Total Miles</u>: This equals total IRP Miles. For those carriers who do not report mileage under IRP, the total miles should be determined by using the beginning and ending odometer readings from the vehicles operated in your fleet from July 1 - June 30.

LINE 3 – Total Missouri Miles: For a new license, estimated miles are acceptable. Missouri miles are the same as reported for the International Registration Plan when apportioned license plates were obtained. Carriers who do not report IRP mileage should include all mileage from, to or through Missouri. All miles traveled transporting containers with residues of hazardous materials remaining in packaging, including a tank car, after its contents have been unloaded to the maximum extent practicable and before packaging is either refilled or cleaned of hazardous material and purged to remove any hazardous vapors.

<u>LINE 5 – Number of Missouri Hazardous Waste Shipments:</u> To determine the number of hazardous waste shipments transported from, to or through Missouri for the preceding year, use hazardous waste manifests, used oil logs or infectious waste shipping papers.

LINE 6 – Total Number of Missouri Shipments: To determine the number of Missouri shipments for the preceding year, use the total number of manifests, shipments and bills of lading for any property transported from, to or through Missouri.

HW-1 FORM INSTRUCTIONS

If an item on the application is not applicable or the correct response is "None", write N/A into the field. Retain a copy of the completed application for your records.

If you have a license to transport hazardous waste and need a 30-day temporary license, or to add or replace power units fill out the HW-2 Form – Supplemental License Certificate for Transporting Hazardous Waste.

SECTION 1 - TYPE OF REGISTRATION

- A. TYPE OF TRANSPORTER Check all boxes that apply.
- B. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS Check all types of hazardous materials you transport.

The classes and divisions selected must be registered with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration.

Even though infectious waste is not considered hazardous waste under federal law, Missouri law requires a Hazardous Waste License for the transportation of this material.

SECTION 2 - GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>USDOT Number</u> – A USDOT number is required to transport hazardous waste in the state of Missouri. A USDOT number can be obtained www.fmcsa.dot.gov/tegistration.

FEIN Number/Social Security Number — An FEIN number is a federal Tax ID number. A sole proprietor who does not have an FEIN number should enter a Social Security Number.

EPA ID Number – An EPA number is required for the transportation of hazardous waste, except for infectious waste. If you do not hav e an EPA number you must complete Form MO -780-1164. This form can be obtained from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources at www.dnr.mo.gov.

Name of Carrier – This is the company name or legal name you use to do business. This name MUST be the same as the name registered with the FMCSA and the Missouri Secretary of State, if applicable. All Limited Partnerships, Corporations and Limited Liability Companies must register with the Missouri Secretary of State unless the principal place of business is outside of the state of Missouri and the company participates in interstate commerce as defined in section 390.020, RSMo. Legal name registrations can be filed online at www.sos.mo.gov or by calling 1.866.223.6535.

Doing Business As (DBA) Name – A DBA is a name that a company may use that is different from their legal company name. If using a DBA name, it MUST be registered with the Missouri Secretary of State unless the principal place of business is outside of the state of Missouri and the company participates in interstate commerce as defined in section 390.020, RSMo. Fictitious name registrations can be filed online at www.sos.mo.gov or by calling 1.866.223.6535.

Principle Place of Business — The Principle Place of Business address is the location where the safety records of the company are kept or can be made available. This must be a physical location, not a PO Box.

Mailing Address – Enter the mailing address if different than the principal place of business address. This address may be a PO box.

<u>Missouri Branch Offices, Terminals & Transfer Stations</u> – List the addresses of all branch offices, terminals or transfer stations located in the state of Missouri. If none, check the box that states there are no branch offices, terminals or transfer stations in the state.

SECTION 3 - PUBLIC LIABILITY SECURITY-INSURANCE

The company's insurance company must file the required insurance forms BEFORE a hazardous waste license will be issued. This form must include: Motor Carrier Name, DBA Name (if applicable), & Business Address as reflected in Section 2.

THIS MUST BE THE SAME AS THE NAME REGISTERED WITH THE FMCSA AND THE MISSOURI SECRETARY OF STATE, if applicable.

SECTION 4 – REGISTERED AGENT FOR SERVICE OF PROCESS IN MISSOURI

If the principal place of business is NOT in Missouri the <u>name and address</u> of a process agent based in Missouri where service can be made on the business <u>MUST</u> be provided. *This must be the name of an individual, not an organization, and the address must be a physical location, not a PO Box.* The FMCSA provides a list of some process agents on their website at <u>www.fmcsa.dot.gov/registration/process-agents</u>.

SECTION 5 - FORM OF BUSINESS

- **A. BUSINESS TYPE** Check the box that represents the type of business. This MUST be the same as the type of business registered with the Missouri Secretary of State, if applicable. Enter the company date of incorporation, state of incorporation, and state registration number.
- **B. CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING** Indicate if the company is in good standing with the registration state. If not required to register with the Missouri Secretary of State, a certificate of good stand ing from the registration state MUST be provided. Partnerships must provide a copy of the partnership agreement (new license only).
- C. COMPANY OFFICERS List the company's officers, partners, or members and their titles. This is not required for sole proprietors.

SECTION 6 - REGULATORY LICENSE FEES

The application must be accompanied with the hazardous waste fee calculated in Section 9. Checks can be made payable to the Director of Revenue.

SECTION 7 – SAFETY COMPLIANCE & SIGNATURE

Read this section carefully before signing and submitting the application. The company is bound by commercial motor vehicles safety regulations. Information about the safety regulations that apply to hazardous waste license holders can be found in the Safety & Compliance section of the MoDOT Motor Carrier Services website at www.modot.org/mcs.

The application must be signed to be accepted. If an individual other than the applicant signs the application, proof of power of attorney must be submitted. If the applicant is a corporation, an officer of the company or an individual authorized to sign on behalf of the company may sign the application. A member or manager of an LLC may sign the application as long as the member or manager is authorized to sign on behalf of the LLC as stated in the articles of incorporation or operating agreement.

SECTION 8 - AUTHORIZED 24-HOUR CONTACT PERSON

Provide the name, address and phone numbers of the authorized 24 -hour contact person. This portion of the application must include a 24 -hour contact phone number to be accepted.

SECTION 9 – LICENSE FEE CALCULATION FOR TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS WASTE

No carrier will be required to pay more than \$25,000 per year for a license to transport hazardous waste. Carriers who pay this amount are not required to complete Section 9.

For the first year of operation, loads and miles will need to be estimated if unknown. If estimates are used, adjustments will be made upon renewal after the first year of operation for any amount over or under the fee paid using the actual amounts from the initial year of operation.

For the second year renewal, actual Missouri mileage and total miles must be reported for the preceding year. The preceding year is the 12 consecutive months immediately prior to July 1 prior to the hazardous waste license year. Any amount owed or credited for the second year will be included in the renewal fee if estimates were used in the initial year.

Total Missouri Miles - For a new license, estimated miles are acceptable. Missouri miles are the same as reported for the International Registration Plan when apportioned license plates were obtained. Carriers who do not report IRP mileage should include all mileage to or through Missouri. All miles traveled transporting containers with residues of hazardous materials as defined in 49 CFR 171.8 should be included in Missouri hazardous waste mileage. This includes hazardous materials remaining in packaging, including a tank car, after its contents have been unloaded to the maximum extent practicable and before packaging is either refilled or cleaned of hazardous material and purged to remove an hazardous vapors.

Total Miles – This equals total IRP miles. Carriers who do not report IRP mileage should determine total miles by using the beginning and ending odometer readings from the vehicles operated in the fleet from July 1 to June 30.

Missouri Hazardous Waste Shipments – To determine the number of hazardous waste shipments transported from, to or through Missouri for the preceding year, use hazardous waste manifests, used oil logs or infectious waste shipping papers.

Total Number of Missouri Shipments – To determine the number of Missouri shipments for the preceding year, use the total number of manifests, shipments and bills of lading for any property transported from, to or through Missouri.

Preceding Year – 12 consecutive months immediately prior to July 1, immediately preceding the commencement of the license year for which the license is being sought.

SECTION 10 – DESCRIPTION OF EQUIPMENT

Provide a complete description of each type of cargo equipment to be used for the transportation of hazardous waste. **Do not list each piece of equipment in this table.**

Copies of DOT exemption paper and extensions, if the exemptions have expired, must be submitted for DOT exempt cargo tanks.

SECTION 11 – DESCRIPTION OF POWER UNITS

Provide a description of each power unit to be used for the transportation of hazardous waste.

Gross Vehicle Weight Rating is defined as the value specified by the manufacturer or manufacturers as the maximum loaded weight of a single or combination vehicle.

License Vehicle Weight Rating is the gross weight of the vehicle (power unit) plus the maximum load to be carried or pulled at any one time allowed by Missouri law. Please review these carefully. The licensed weight for Missouri should be one of the following: 6,000, 12,000, 18,000, 24,000, 30,000, 36,000, 42,000, 48,000, 54,000, 60,010, 66,000, 73,280, 78,000 or 8 0,000 pounds. If your licensed weight is different from those listed, round up to the nearest weight.
