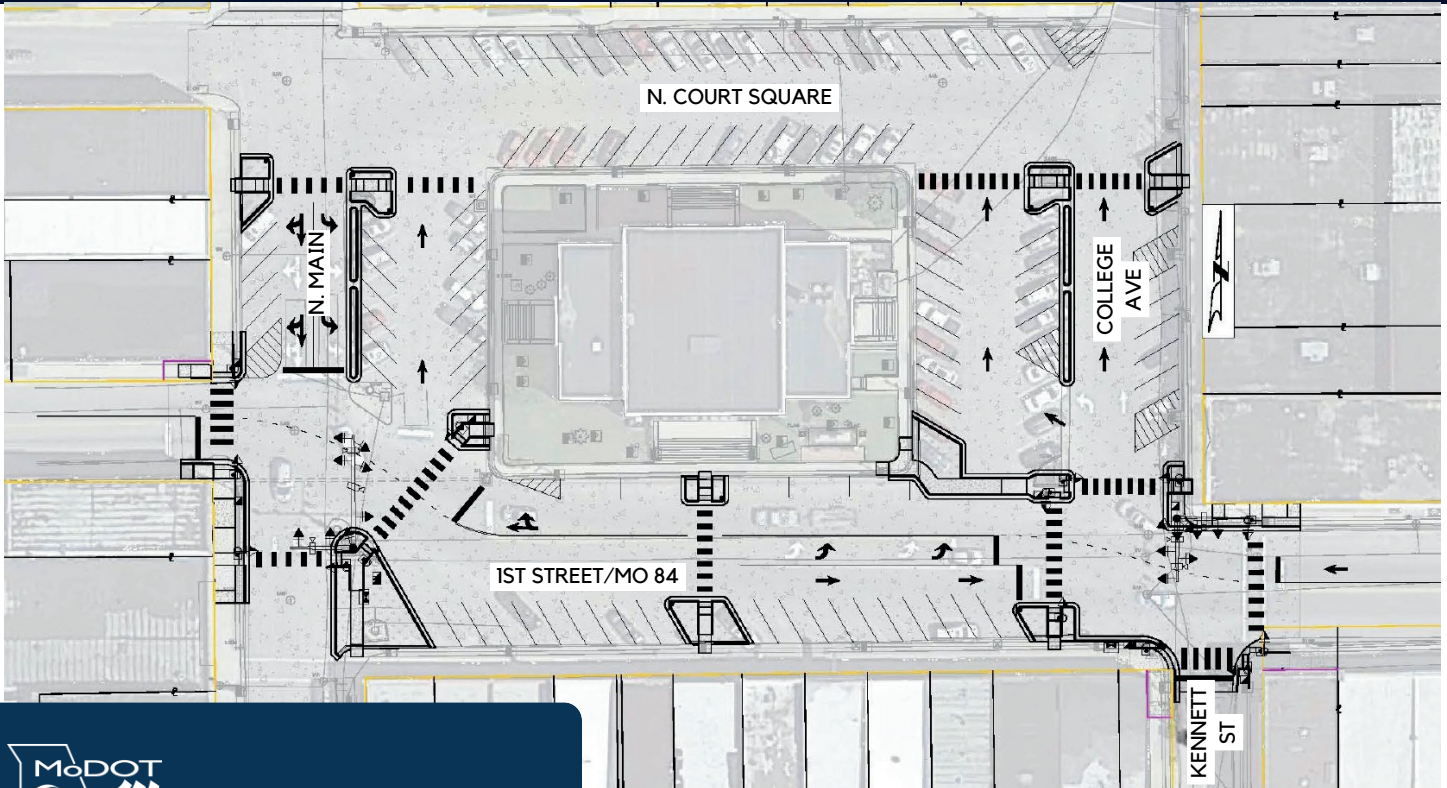


DUNKLIN COUNTY

ROUTE 84 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS IN KENNETT, MO



The project will deliver a series of roadway and traffic improvements around the Dunklin County Courthouse, including Route 84 (1st Street), Main Street, Kennett Street, and the Courthouse Square. This safety improvement project includes updating the outdated signal equipment, improving accessibility for pedestrians and enhancing efficiency. The pedestrian improvements are part of MoDOT's initiative to bring roadway facilities into compliance with the current standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

KEY IMPROVEMENTS

- **NEW DRIVING SURFACE**
Paving Route 84, Main St., Kennett St., & the Courthouse Square
- **NEW, UPDATED TRAFFIC SIGNALS**
Intersections of Route 84/Main St. and Route 84/Kennett St.
- **RECONFIGURED PARKING LOTS**
East and West Sides of the Dunklin County Courthouse
- **SIMPLIFIED LAYOUT AT MAIN ST. INTERSECTION**
Larger Island to Help Mitigate Potential Driver Confusion
- **PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IN FRONT OF COURTHOUSE**
Enhances Pedestrian Visibility in Area with Foot Traffic

PROJECT TIMELINE

Tentatively, the project could be let in March 2027, with construction beginning as early as May 2027. Once construction starts, work will be underway for approximately three months.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

During construction, motorists should anticipate lane closures with flaggers in place to guide traffic through the work zone.
