PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Type of work: Bridge replacement.

Improvements: Wider bridge.

Construction expected: 2027.

Estimated cost: \$2 million, including engineering and construction costs. Subject to change.

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PROJECT DETAILS

Why is this work needed?

The Phelps County Route HH bridge over Spring Creek, north of Rolla, is slated for replacement in 2027. Built in 1958, the bridge is in poor condition, showing signs it has reached the end of its useful life, and in need of replacement.

Proposed improvements

- New 24-foot-wide, two-lane bridge. Two feet wider than the current bridge.
- Replacing current railings with new barriers.
- Installing new pavement marking and approach pavement.

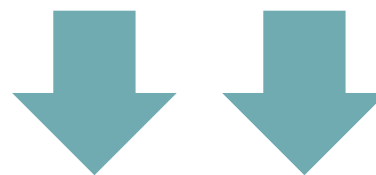
Traffic Impacts

Construction will require a full roadway closure for approximately five months.

No detour will be signed, but motorists will be alerted well ahead of the closure to use an alternate route.

Current Proposed Timeline

Jan. 2027: Contractors submit competitive bids.

Feb. 2027: Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract.

March 2027: If awarded in January, earliest contractor may begin work.

Dec. 2027: Anticipated project completion.



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
