



WESTBOUND I-44/MISSOURI ROUTE 43 BRIDGE REHABILITATION

NEWTON COUNTY



PROJECT FACTS

- Rehabilitate westbound I-44 bridge over Missouri Route 43 at Exit 6 in Joplin
- Project includes replacing bridge deck/driving surface and various repairs to bridge substructure



CONSTRUCTION

- Construction to begin spring 2024
- Construction completed by winter 2024
- Estimated project cost: \$3.1 million



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Traffic reduced to one lane in each direction between 10 p.m.-7 a.m.
- Two lanes of traffic OPEN in each direction during daytime hours
- Both ramps to I-44 CLOSED during project



BRIDGE FACTS

- Bridge built in 1956
- Bridge carries 23,000 vehicles a day
- 30% of traffic is from trucks
- Bridge in poor condition requiring frequent maintenance
