

I-55 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS

INTERCHANGES IN JEFFERSON COUNTY


PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

Interstate 55 is a key north-south corridor through Missouri, linking Greater St. Louis to: Chicago, Illinois; Memphis, Tennessee; Jackson, Mississippi; and New Orleans, Louisiana. The I-55/U.S. 67 interchange provides access to the Ozark National Scenic Riverway, the Mark Twain National Forest, and cities and towns like Farmington and Poplar Bluff. Daily and recreational traffic along the I-55 corridor has led to periodic traffic congestion. The prevalence of drivers unfamiliar with the area in a high-speed environment has led to a three-year crash rate that is 26.7% above the statewide rate for interstates. Combined with the growing population in Jefferson County, there are opportunities to improve the traffic flow, safety and infrastructure along this corridor.

The purpose of this project is to address traffic and safety concerns along the corridor and account for future development and growth patterns in the region. The next phases of the project involves preliminary design of the recommended alternative, additional study of traffic patterns, safety, roadway conditions, noise analysis, and environmental documentation. Throughout this process, MoDOT will seek input and feedback from residents and highway users in the surrounding area. Your input and thoughts will help the MoDOT project team determine plans that are informed by the community.

PROJECT AREA



The project area on Interstate 55 is between the Route Z interchange and the U.S. 67 interchange, including the cities of Pevely, Herculaneum, Festus and Crystal City.
