Last month, we announced the selection of Millstone Weber, in partnership with Parsons, as the team to design and construct the I-70 Cave Springs to Fairgrounds Road Design-Build project. I'm pleased to announce that as of March 1, we now have signed a contract with the team. That means we are officially moving forward with the next steps – **final design and, this summer, construction.**

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The I-70 Cave Springs to Fairgrounds Design-Build Project will maximize improvements to address:

- ✓ Local Connectivity, Safety, Traffic Congestion
- ✓ Long-Lasting Infrastructure with Future Expansion in Mind

The big question surrounding the project is what will happen to the outer roads.

The existing outer roads between Cave Springs and Fairgrounds will remain two-way. There will also be a new north outer road built between Zumbahl and Fairgrounds/Convention Center.

New interchanges will be constructed at Cave Springs Road and Zumbahl Road, and both will include a pedestrian shared use path over the interstate.



WHAT'S NEXT

Planning for a public meeting is underway. The meeting, which will be held before construction begins, will outline additional details on the improvements, as well as impacts and project schedule.



Construction is scheduled to begin this summer and is anticipated to be complete by June 28, 2024.
