- 3. Provide a durable and maintainable transportation system compatible with regional development.
- 4. Construct the project safely and minimize impacts to customers.
- 5. Complete the project on schedule utilizing a diverse workforce.



- One of the heaviest traveled interstates in Missouri
- I-55: 70,000 ADT, US-67: 35,000 ADT
- I-55: 16% heavy trucks, US-67: 8.6% heavy trucks

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






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Peak Hour Congestion



Utilities

Pipelines

- Enable Pipeline crosses I-55 near BNSF Railroad north of Route Z (Reimbursable).
- Energy Transfer Pipeline crosses US-67 east of Route CC (Reimbursable).
- Lumen (previously CenturyLink)
 - Developing a design at MoDOT's expense to move facilities from I-55 median to utility corridor along I-55.
 - Potential for early relocates, but we will be coordinating with the successful proposer based on design during the contract.
- Other Utilities within project limits
 - MoDOT has been meeting with Utilities to discuss the project and requesting UIS based on Preferred Alternative design as a reference that will be provided.
 - Ameren, Spire, Charter, ATT-D, ATT-T, MCI Verizon, municipal water and sewer.

Workforce

- Federal workforce goals apply to project
 - 14.7% minority
 - 6.9% female
- Goals apply per craft
- On-The-Job Training (OJT) Requirements
 - Minimum of 4 construction OJTs with 1000 hours each
 - Eligible \$10 per hour incentive





Disadvantaged Business Enterprise

- 12% for construction activities
- 18% for professional services activities
- DBE firms must be certified with the Missouri Regional Certification Committee (MRCC)

 - As-built plans
 - CADD files with right of way and utilities
- To be released at a later date:
 - CE2
 - Geotechnical report
 - Proposed bridge Type, Size, and Locations (TSL)
 - VISSIM models
 - Draft ITP

Draft Configuration Requirements

- Resurface and replace signals on Route A from Collins Road to Route 61, including South Mill Street and West Gannon Drive.
- Rehabilitate bridges:
 - Metropolitan Blvd. over Glaize Creek
 - I-55 NB over Route M
 - I-55 SB over Route M
 - I-55 NB at Route M ramp over Glaize Creek
- Resurface pavement and upgrade guardrail on I-55 from Route M to Route Z.
- If replacing the I-55 bridge over McNutt Street, accommodate a future 10' multi-use path under I-55.
- Construct grade-separated interchange at US-67 and Route CC.
