Improve I-70 Innovations Lead

The Missouri Department of Transportation is seeking an Innovations Lead to conduct research focusing on innovation in technology, funding, and policy development for the statewide Improve I-70 Program. This program includes the planning, design, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, and repair of three lanes in each direction on approximately 200 miles of I-70.

The Innovations Lead will set the direction for innovations in program delivery, including coordinating with staff to identify, develop, and facilitate innovative options for the Improve I-70 Program. Expected duties include working with internal and external partners to find innovative options to optimize the overall success of the program.

Requirements to be Considered

- Bachelor's Degree: Economics, Engineering (Civil, Industrial, or Mechanical), Logistics, Planning, Political Science, Public Administration, Statistics, or related field.
- Eight years of experience in transportation or policy development and administration.
