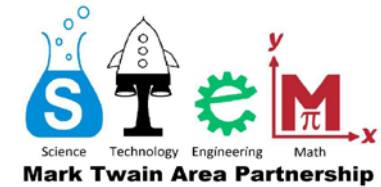


Mark Twain Area STEM Camp 2019



Mark Twain Area Summer STEM Camps: Students who meet the following criteria and who are interested in careers in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering or Math) are eligible to apply to attend a one week STEM Camp. The STEM Camps will be held the weeks of May 28-31, 2019 and June 24-28, 2019 and will occur daily from 8:30 AM – 2:45 PM. Participants will visit daily and participate in many hands-on activities at various Hannibal industry partners. Transportation from HHS will be provided daily to the industry and back to HHS at the end of the day. A maximum of 24 students will be accepted to the program each week and lunch will be provided daily at the site of the industry. Students will be admitted on a first come, first served basis. A waiting list will be developed if each week's camp exceeds the 24-student capacity. Students will only be allowed to attend one week of STEM camp unless space allows for repeaters.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be entering grades 9-11 during the 2019-2020 school year
- Students must be in good standing at his/her sending school. Areas that will be looked at to determine eligibility include grades, attendance, and discipline records.
- Equal consideration and impartial treatment regardless of race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, socio-economic status, marital status, sex, age, handicapping conditions or organizational membership. Minority and underrepresented classes are encouraged!
