

# **INVITATION TO BID**

## **CITY OF WAYNESVILLE HISTORIC ROUTE 66**

### **SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS - PHASE I**

### **SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS - PHASE II**

Sealed bids for the Proposal for the Construction of City of Waynesville TAP-9901(536) Historic Route 66 Sidewalk Improvements - Phase I and Sidewalk Improvements Phase II will be received at: City of Waynesville, 100 Tremont Center, Waynesville, MO 65583, until 11:00 A.M. (prevailing local time) on the 24th day of September, 2025, at the office of the City Administrator, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted as a Hard Copy.

The proposed work includes:

The furnishing of all material, labor, and equipment for the construction of sidewalk improvements along Historic Route 66 beginning at the Morgan Street intersection and proceeding northeasterly to the Belle Street intersection. This includes curb and gutter with 6 foot wide sidewalk, ADA accessible curb ramps with truncated domes, curb inlets, 15-18 inch storm pipes, 7 and 8 inch concrete pavement drives, seeding, mulching, traffic control, modular block retaining wall, and other related work.

The furnishing of all material, labor, and equipment for the construction of sidewalk improvements along Historic Route 66 beginning at the Ichord Avenue intersection and ending approximately 350 feet west of Broadway Avenue. This includes curb and gutter with 6 foot wide sidewalk, ADA accessible curb ramps with domes, storm boxes and 18 and 30 inch storm pipes, a box culvert extension, retaining wall, and other related work.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 AM on the 16th day of September, at Waynesville City Hall, 100 Tremont Center, Waynesville, MO 65583. This is a non-mandatory conference but all bidders are encouraged to attend.

This contract requires payment of the prevailing hourly rate of wages for each craft or type of work required to execute the contract as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, and requires adherence to a schedule of minimum wages as determined by the United States Department of Labor. For work performed anywhere on this project, the contractor and the contractor's subcontractors shall pay the higher of these two applicable wage rates. The applicable state wage rates for this contract are detailed in "Annual Wage Order 32", that is attached to this bidding document. The applicable federal wage rates for this contract are the effective Davis-Bacon federal wage rates posted the tenth day before the bid opening date and can be found at: <https://sam.gov/content/wage-determinations>. These supplemental bidding documents have important legal consequences. It shall be conclusively presumed that they are in the bidder's possession, and they have been reviewed and used by the bidder in the preparation of any bid submitted on this project.

The City of Waynesville hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2025, First Edition. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

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Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects shall provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Waynesville reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The DBE Goal for City of Waynesville TAP-9901(536) Historic Route 66 Sidewalk Improvements - Phase I is 4%.

The DBE Goal for City of Waynesville TAP-9901(551) Historic Route 66 Sidewalk Improvements - Phase I is 3%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
