

## INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for Interchange Improvements of I-470 and View High Drive MoDOT STIP No: J4I3470 will be received at: Fogel-Anderson Construction Co., 1212 E. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, MO 64106 until 2:00 o'clock P.M. CST on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 2024, at the office of the Fogel-Anderson Construction Co., 1212 E. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Kansas City, MO 64106. All bids will be opened in private.

All bids shall be submitted by mail or hand delivered to Fogel-Anderson Construction Co. Bids shall be received prior to the time of bids due. Bids received after said time will be returned to the Bidder unopened. Bids must be submitted upon the Bid Form included in the Project Manual. No oral, telegraphic, facsimile, or telephonic proposals or modifications will be considered. Bidders will be notified of the Bid Opening results upon written request.

The proposed work includes: Grading, paving, storm drainage, lighting, signals, signing, and retaining walls along View High Drive, Meers Road, and Ramps to and from I-470. The interchange of I-470 and View High Drive will be improved to a Diverging Diamond Interchange. Also included are the Water Main Relocation at Meers Road & View High Drive, the KCMO Sanitary Sewer Relocation (Paragon Star Development), and the View High Drive Trail Project.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 8:30 AM on the 22nd day of May, 2024, at the Paragon Star project site. Meeting to be held at Fogel-Anderson Construction trailer. All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The I-470 Western Gateway TDD hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% off the total bid shall be submitted with each proposal. The Bid Security shall be made payable to The I-470 Western Gateway TDD.

The I-470 Western Gateway TDD reserves the right to reject any or all bids, reject a bid not accompanied by other data required by the Bidding Documents, and reject a bid which is in any way incomplete or irregular.
