Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of the online meeting?

The purpose of the online meeting is to provide information on plans to redeck and replace the superstructure (girders) of the bridge over Bois Brule Creek on Missouri Route H between Route E and Route BB, approximately 4 miles north of Henley.

Why is this work necessary?

The existing bridge over First Creek was built in 1963 and is fifty-seven years old. The condition of the bridge has reached a point where it is necessary to replace the bridge deck and bridge superstructure (girders).

How will traffic be affected?

During construction, Route H will be closed at the bridge location for up to three months. Signs will alert motorists of the closed road and the detour route will be signed during construction.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled to be awarded in the fall of 2020, with construction taking place in 2021.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?

No right of way or easement will be required for the bridge project.

What will the project cost?

The total construction cost is approximately \$654,000.
