Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of the online meeting?

The purpose of the online meeting is to provide information on plans to perform preventative maintenance on the Route AE bridge over US 54 in Callaway County, on the Route 94 bridge over Little Tavern Creek in Callaway County, and on the West Main Street bridge over US 54 in Cole County.

Why is this work necessary?

The bridges are in need of new deck surface overlays to maintain the bridges in good condition and to prevent deck deterioration.

How will traffic be affected?

During construction, the Route AE bridge will be closed for 7 days. Signs will alert motorists of the closed road and a detour will be signed to alternate state routes. Route AE bridge and guardrail work should take approximately 4 weeks.

The Route 94 bridge will be limited to one-way traffic, controlled by a temporary traffic signal. Route 94 bridge work should take approximately 2 weeks.

The West Main Street bridge work will be done one-lane-at-a-time, with two-way traffic being maintained at all times. West Main Street bridge and signal work should take approximately 6 weeks. This work must be done within the months of June 2020 through November 2020. There will be occasional single-lane closures on US54 and West McCarty Ramp closures during nighttime hours.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled to be awarded in early 2020, with construction taking place in 2020.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct these projects?

No additional right of way will be required for this project.

What will the project cost?

The total construction cost is approximately \$550,000.
