

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

U.S. 61 AT DONNA DRIVE IN JACKSON, MO

ABOUT

The U.S. 61 at Donna Drive project extends from the Kimbel Lane intersection to the Donna Drive intersection along U.S. 61 in Jackson, Missouri.

The proposed project upgrades the traffic signal infrastructure at the U.S. 61 and Donna Drive intersection, addresses two closely spaced intersections, and provides a U.S. 61 pedestrian crossing.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The following are the expected improvements:

- Widen U.S. 61 with eastbound and westbound right turn lanes at Donna Drive
- Replace the Donna Drive span wire signals with mast arm mounted signals
- Replace lighting, signing, and pavement markings
- Convert the southern Kimbel Lane approach to a right in/ right out intersection
- Provide a north-south pedestrian crossing

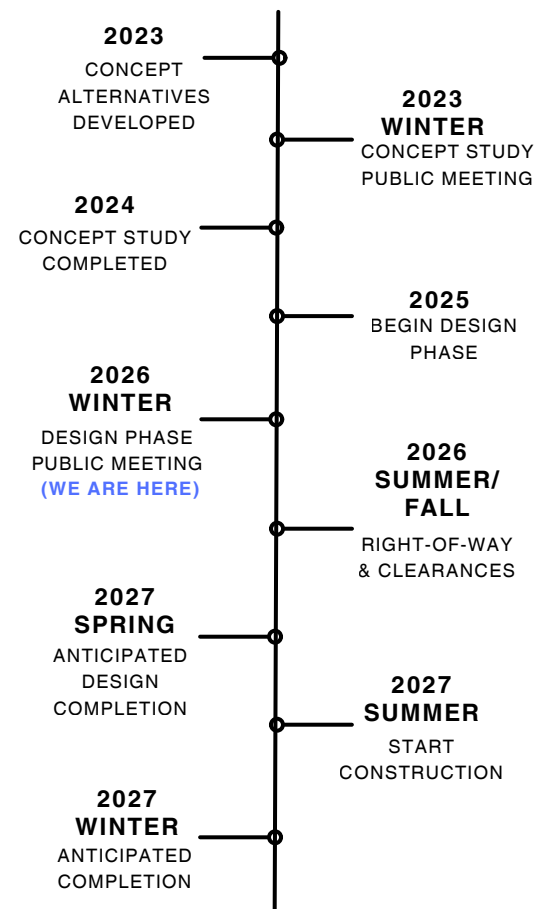
EXPECTED ADVANTAGES

- Separate slowing and turning traffic from the U.S. 61 main lane traffic
- Provide dedicated turn lanes to address the predominant crash type, rear end crashes
- Provide a pedestrian connection
- Update aging infrastructure

TRAFFIC

- U.S. 61 will remain open with temporary lane closures, signal adjustments, and periodic sidewalk closures
- Minor traffic impacts expected, with most work occurring during off-peak hours
- Kimbel Lane traffic will be detoured to use Donna Drive with advance signage
