Bid documents will be available on October 5, 2017 for the **ROCK ISLAND CORRIDOR SHARED USE PATH**. All sealed proposal bids must be submitted to the office of the Director of Public Works, Engineering Division, 303 W. Walnut, Independence, Missouri 64050, prior to 2:00 p.m. on November 2, 2017. Sealed proposals will be opened on November 2, 2017 at 2:05 p.m. at that same address. A pre-bid meeting will be conducted on Thursday, October 12, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in The Historic Truman Courthouse Large Meeting Room (2nd Floor) at 112 W Lexington Ave, Independence, MO 64050. The conference call number is 877-402-9753, Access Code 8432129. Bidders are required to attend the pre-bid meeting in person or via conference call.

Project location: Beginning near the intersection of Brickyard and Noland Roads in Raytown, extending south and east for approximately 6.43 miles and ending near the intersection of Jefferson Street and Scherer Road in Lee's Summit, all in Jackson County, Missouri.

Work Items included: Aggregate trail construction, paved trail construction, ADA ramp construction, bridge rehabilitation, culvert construction, signals, striping, signing, erosion control, and drainage improvements.

Any Bidder, who has special needs addressed by the Americans with Disabilities Act, should notify the Project Manager at the number listed below, or through the Missouri Relay System. Jackson County hereby notifies all Bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that for any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged, minority and women business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation, and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, gender or national origin, in consideration for an award. A 12 % DBE Goal is a part of this contract, (See DBE Submittal Forms and DBE Provisions 1-14). The sealed Proposals and Bid must be made on the forms provided in the contract documents. Each Proposal must include: 1) the completed bidding documents; 2) a cashier's check drawn on an acceptable bank, or an acceptable bidder's bond, in an amount not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid (all surety performance bonds and surety labor and material bonds must be with companies listed in the Department of the Treasury, Federal Register); and, 3) a completed Compliance Report Form (page AA-1) with current (issued within the last 12 months) Jackson County Certificate of Compliance attached. Failure to complete this report or attach a current certificate as outlined above may result in the rejection of the bid. For information contact the Compliance Review Officer at (816) 881-3302. For an additional \$20.00 fee, plans can be mailed. Checks, if used for payments of deposits, shall be made in favor of the Manager, of Finance. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Returned bids must include the Compliance Report Form (page AA-1) fully completed and signed. If Bidding enterprise has a current (issued within the last 12 months) Certificate of Compliance from Jackson County, Missouri, or the City of Kansas City, Missouri, a copy of the certificate should be attached to this report form. Failure to complete this report or attach a current certificate as outlined above may result in the rejection of the bid.
2. Jackson County is a tax-exempt entity under 144.062, Revised Statutes of Missouri and will issue the contractor and subcontractors an exemption certificate. For information contact Compliance Review Officer at (816) 881-3302.
3. Project inspection by Jackson County, MO or its agent. For information call Project Manager Eric Johnson at (816) 881-4499.
4. Only MoDOT approved Contractors and sub-contractors will be allowed to bid.
5. The 'Bidders Right of Entry' form included with the bidding documents shall be completed and provided to Jackson County prior to any field inspection of the project site during bid preparation.
6. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
7. This contract has a new requirement related to paying wage rates for certain delivery truck drivers. Bidders are advised to read Jackson County Ordinance #4465 in the appendix of the Contract Documents, as well as Jackson County Code Section 1072, enacted by the Jackson County Legislature October 15, 2012.
