Mr. Reeser motioned to approve the Consent Agenda items with amended changes to the minutes. Mr. Campbell seconded; motion carried.

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Aetna Claims Summary (2016/2017) – Mr. Padgett reported Plan medical claim payouts have decreased 4.5% when compared to 2016 through the twelfth month of the 2017 calendar year.

MoDOT/MSHP Prescription Drug Paid Claims Monthly Comparison (2016/2017) - Mr. Padgett reported Plan prescription claims costs have increased 11.3% when

compared to 2016 through the twelth month of the 2017 calendar year.

<u>Subrogation Report-</u> Mr. Denkler updated the Board on the Subrogation report through the end of 2017. He reported there is a 90% close ratio.

EGWP 101- EGWP stands for Employer Group Waiver Plans. EGWPs are employer-only Part D plans with enrollment only open to those with an employement based connection to the EGWP. EGWPs offer enhanced benefits to members by having access to all the rights and protections that are available to all other Medicare beneficiaries. There are two basic categories to EGWPs: the 800 series and the direct contract. The Plan is considered a direct contract plan. This is offered by employers or unions that directly contract with CMS to become PDP sponsors or MA organizations for their members and the employer is self-insured.

4th Quarter Update- Ms. Keeven reviewed the 4th quarter report with the Board. Ms. Keeven reported that the Copay Assistance program has saved the Plan \$1,347,462 as of 4th quarter 2017. The Plan currently has 187 members utilizing drugs on the Copay assistance with a total drug count of 50.

Other Business- Ms. Halford updated the Board on the AON RFP proposal in Closed Session. Mr. Coffey motioned to approve the AON RFP proposal. Mr. Schwartze seconded; motion carried.

CDL update- additional information has been provided to the Board for coverage of the CDL physical exams. Mr. Schwartze motioned to allow the employees to receive the preventive physical or the CDL physical for in network providers. Capt. Remillard seconded; motion carried.

Mr. schwartze requested an update on the RFP process for medical providers.

Capt. Remillard motioned to adjourn at 10:57 a.m. Mr. Campbell seconded; motion carried.
