- Our safe driving signs promote Buckle Up Phone Down, School Bus Safety, and Watch for Motorcycles

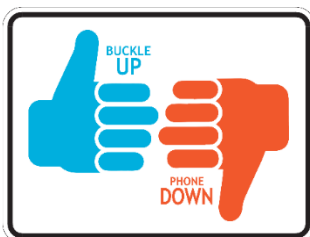
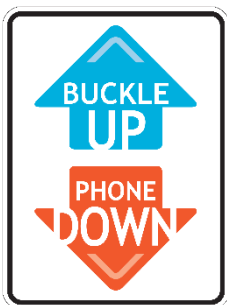
Tips for Installation

- Ideas on placement include an existing metal post or a permanent structure already in your parking lot, or add a metal post where cars exit
- These signs are intended to be placed in areas like parking lots and exits to convey the message BEFORE drivers get onto an active roadway
- Signs are not permitted on MoDOT right-of-way (MoDOT owned property)
- They cannot be fixed to any roadway signs, such as stop signs
- Signs are not designed for use along streets or highways because the letter size is too small to be read at high speeds
- School bus safety signs are to be placed at residences and around school zones

Other Details

- The entity will have to use appropriate hardware to support the sign and install it themselves
- MoDOT is not responsible for the installation
- Metal signs are intended to last 10+ years
- Yard signs are intended to last for 1 year
