

INVITATION TO BID

MACKVILLE ROAD REPLACEMENT

Sealed bids for the Proposal for the Construction of Mackville Road Roadway Replacement will be received at: Lincoln County, 201 Main Street, Troy, Missouri 63379, , until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 7th day of March 2017, at the office of the Lincoln County Courthouse, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted as a Hard Copy.

The proposed work includes:

Construction of approximately 600-feet long by 24-feet wide by 8-inch thick non-reinforced concrete roadway with minor grading and CMPs in Lincoln County, Missouri, Survey 1744, Township 50 North, Range 1 West

A digital copy of the plans and specifications may be purchased through the office of the Great River Engineering (GRE), upon payment of \$50.00, which is not refundable. All bidders must purchase plans through Great River Engineering, Inc. and be on the planholder list in order to bid the project.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (State Wage Rate).

The Lincoln County hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects shall provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The Lincoln County reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
