



MISSOURI ROUTE 39 & ROUTE N BRIDGE REPLACEMENT & REHABILITATION Cedar County



PROJECT FACTS

- Replace Route 39/Cedar Creek bridge with a wider and longer structure
- Route 39 will get barrier walls, permanent striping, guardrail
- Route N/Big Sac River bridge will get new deck/driving surface and object markers at each end



CONSTRUCTION

- Construction begins Spring 2027
- Estimated total cost: \$4.5 million



TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Each bridge closed for up to four (4) months during construction
- No signed detour
- Access to property on either end of bridge will be maintained



BRIDGE FACTS

- Route 39 bridge built in 1949, carries approximately 510 vehicles per day
- Route N bridge built in 1953, carries approximately 345 vehicles per day
