PROJECT FACTS

The \$246 million dollar Interstate 55 Corridor Improvements Project will involve constructing a third lane on I-55 in both directions from Route Z to U.S. Route 67 in Jefferson County. One of the goals of the project is to alleviate congestion by extending the southbound third lane from Route Z to the U.S. Route 67 Interchange. The KCI Team-comprised of KCI Construction Company, Bartlett & West, and Wilson & Company – will replace the existing signalized intersection at U.S. Route 67 and Route CC with an interchange that will allow free-flowing traffic of U.S. Route 67 under a new Route CC bridge. Construction is currently underway. The construction project is scheduled to be completed by December 2026.

Additional project details include:

- Constructing new interchanges at Route Z, McNutt, and US 67/I-55
- Adding lanes at the SB I-55 to SB US 67 ramp and the NB 67 to NB I-55 ramp
- Replacing 14 bridges
- Rehabilitating 12 bridges

Over 50,000 vehicles travel through this corridor daily. Motorists will continue to be able to use two lanes northbound and southbound on I-55 and US 67 during daytime hours of construction.

The I-55 Corridor Improvements Project will be completed using a Design-Build delivery method that involves hiring one contracting team (*KCI*) to complete the design work and build the highway improvement under one contract. MoDOT provides the project goals, budget and schedule and the contractor team completes the work. This technique has been known to significantly save time and provide cost savings.
