Ms. Halford reported Plan prescription claims costs have increased 7.2% when compared to 2018 through the second month of the 2019 calendar year.

2019 Wellness Budget- Ms. Halford discussed with the Board the possibility of continuing to authorize a Wellness Budget for 2019. Mr. Reeser motioned to approve \$20,000 dedicated to the Wellness Budget. Ms. Harrmann seconded; motioned carried.
