McDonald County Route EE Bridge Replacement Over Indian Creek in Lanagan

Project Facts:

- Replace Route EE truss bridge over Indian Creek in Lanagan
- New bridge will be four feet higher, 77 feet longer, six feet wider with no truss
- Built in 1928, bridge in deteriorating condition
- Currently, 956 vehicles a day cross the bridge
- This bridge is included in Gov. Mike Parson's \$351 million Focus on Bridges program, which will repair or replace 250 bridges across the state.



Traffic Impacts:

- Route EE CLOSED up to five months at the bridge during construction
- Drivers will have access to property at both ends of the bridge but will not be able to travel through work zone
- Drivers directed to signed detour along routes 59, 76, 90 & H

Construction:

Beginning Spring 2021

Estimated Total Cost:

\$2.3 million
