Mobile Attenuator Tester



Description and Benefit

The Mobile Attenuator Tester is a portable solution that allows technicians to test attenuators without using a truck. It verifies the CMS board (wired or wireless), lifting components, panic lights, and additional top lights, as well as trailer plug functions like turn signals, brake lights, running lights, and the accessory pin powering the DVR system. This ensures the attenuator is correctly wired and ready for installation. By quickly diagnosing whether issues stem from the truck or the TMA, the tester saves time, reduces repair costs, and simplifies troubleshooting. For example, if a turn signal fails, the tester confirms whether the problem lies in the truck or the attenuator, streamlining repairs and improving efficiency.

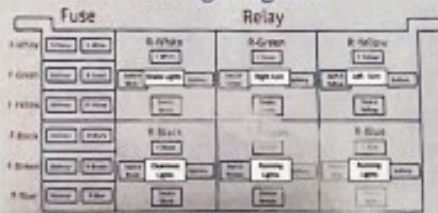
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Wiring Diagram



Wire Specifications

The colors of wires stand for the wires of different relays (Available relay wires includes: White, Green, Yellow, Black, Brown and Blue). Please pay attention to the thickness of wires: Thin wires need to be connected to switches, and the thick wires need to be connected to the devices. As for the rest wires: Red wires are the positive poles of fuses, need to be connected to the battery+. Grey wire is the other side of relay coils, needs to be connected to battery-.
