

Natural Bridge Safety Project

November 2020 update



Here's an update of what you might expect during November along the Natural Bridge corridor.

Crews are going to continue working on the corridor as long as the weather permits. We have finished putting down the new driving surface along the corridor and still have a few areas where we need to finish the work on the new medians. For the most part, though, our efforts will be working on the roundabouts at Salisbury/Parnell and at Vandeventer.

Again, since much of the roadway has been set up for the work, there should be little additional impacts to traffic. There will, however be impacts to on-street parking, especially near the roundabout construction, so please be aware and move any parked vehicles along the roadway. We do ask, as always, to be aware as you travel through the work zone. If you do drive through the work zone, please slow down, put your phone down and put your seat belt on. The crews are working toward making Natural Bridge safer for you – so please help keep them safe. Also, please make sure that you use the marked driving lanes, and do not use the parking areas to pass – there have been several areas where we have installed concrete bump outs in the parking lanes for safety.



During October, 29 percent of the team working on the project were minority workers. We still have about 17 percent of the contract work being completed by disadvantaged business enterprise companies, and are still working through the process to get the minority owned concrete supplier certified.
