THE PRIZES

- The **grand prize winner** will receive \$600 and a trophy. \$200 will be awarded to one entry in each competition category. The grand prize winner will have their trash can displayed at the MoDOT building on the State Fairgrounds during the State Fair in August, with permission of the winning school.

THE RULES

- Decorate a **30-gallon (or larger) trash can** to be located in a prominent area of the school or community. Each design must include the No MORE Trash! logo and a litter-prevention slogan. Use of recycled materials is encouraged. Only entries submitted by Missouri schools, including home schools, will be accepted. Schools may submit one entry in each category: grades K-2, 3-5 and 6-8. Entries must consist of a completed entry form and up to three photographs (photos must be in-focus, provide clear images of the project, and one should include participants). Schools should submit a release form for use of the photo if your school is one of the winners.

THE DEADLINE

- Entries must be submitted online at modot.org/trash-can-contest **no later than March 17**. The winning entries will be announced in early April.
