

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids for Lost Hill Park Greenway Trail Bridge, TAP-9901 (867) (IFB 013-2027) will be received via: **Euna Openbids electronic bid system** until **3:00 o'clock P.M., CST** on the **7th day of October**, and results will be publicly opened and read via teleconference at **(978)990-5387 (Access Code 322594)** at that time. All bids shall be submitted in the form of PDF documents via Euna Openbids.

The proposed work includes: Construction of 10' wide concrete sidewalk, access connections, pedestrian low water crossing, and any incidental work related thereto, in accordance with the plans and specifications. Generally located within the limits of Lost Hill Park near 4705 N Farm Rd. in the City of Springfield, Greene County, Missouri. The total length of the improvements is approximately 433 feet of sidewalk.

A pre-bid conference is scheduled for **September 16th at 10:00 A.M. (CST)**. The pre-bid conference shall be conducted via videoconference. A site visit will follow at 1:00 pm at Lost Hills Park, located at **4705 N. Farm Road 151, Springfield, MO 65803**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The Springfield-Greene County Park Board hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. The bidder will ensure that Disadvantaged Business Enterprises will have the opportunity to participate in the performance of this contract and or any subcontracts. Goals for the amount of work to be awarded to DBE's will be **0%**.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, latest edition, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file seven (7) days prior to bid opening. Bidders are informed that all contractors are subject to full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, and the requirements of the Equal Opportunity Act and it is not the intent of the owner to arbitrarily dismiss any authorities.

Each bidder shall file with his bid a bidder's bond in the amount of **5 percent** of the contract price as indicated per the contract documents. The bidder to whom a contract is awarded will be required to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond on the forms provided, payable to the Springfield-Greene County Park Board, and in the amount of **100 percent** of the contract price in conformity with the requirements of the General Conditions.

Proposals must be on forms provided and all unit price bids, extensions and totals provided thereon shall be completed fully. The Contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder complying with the Conditions of the Contract Documents and within the Owner's budget. The Bidder to whom the awards are made will be notified at the earliest possible date. The Springfield-Greene County Park Board, however, reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any informality in Bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in his interest.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Contractors and subcontractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects must provide proof of participation in a 10-hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

No 2nd tier bidding will be allowed on this project.
