The meeting was called to order at 8:16 a.m.

Mr. Schwartz made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda items. Mr. Padgett seconded; motion carried.

Anthem Claims Summary (2018/2019) – Ms. Halford reported Plan medical claim payouts have decreased 11.9% when compared to 2018 through the tenth month of the 2019 calendar year. This is a savings of \$9.7 million.

MoDOT/MSHP Prescription Drug Paid Claims Monthly Comparison (2018/2019) - Ms. Halford reported Plan prescription claims costs have increased 6.4% when compared to 2018 through the tenth month of the 2019 calendar year.

<u>PillarRx Quarterly Update-</u>Ms. Halford welcomed PillarRx staff to the meeting.

<u>3rd Quarter Report-</u> Ms. Keeven reviewed the 3rd quarter report with the Board. She reported the Copay Assistance program has saved the Plan \$1.4 million year to date for 2019. The Plan currently has 185 members utilizing drugs on Co-pay assistance with a total drug count of 54.

<u>Anthem Quarterly Update-</u> Ms. Halford welcomed Anthem staff to the meeting. Ms. Rector provided an update on how the year has been going since implementation.

<u>3rd Quarter Report-</u> Dr. Moore presented the 3rd quarter report to the Board. He reported a total of \$55.1 million in medical claims has been paid so far in 2019. 95.3% of those claims were paid in network with a total of 57.1% of network discounts.

Mr. Padgett made a motion at 10:01 a.m. to go back into Closed Session to discuss the private duty nursing case. Mr. Coffey seconded; motion carried.

Bariatric Surgery- Dr. Moore discussed bariatric surgery with the Board. The Plan continues to get inquiries from member's regarding the coverage of bariatric procedures. Currently it is an excluded service of the Plan. The Board would like

to see more numbers on the cost and the centers of excellence.

<u>Other Business-</u> The Board discussed the December Board meeting, because it is scheduled for Christmas day. The Board will cancel the meeting and hold an e-meeting if any action items arise.

Mr. Reeser made a motion to adjourn at 11:30 a.m. Master Sgt. Burgeon seconded; motion carried.
