Subject: Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)

Dear Director Hassinger:

As requested in your letter dated July 9, 2025, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) have jointly reviewed the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) FY 2026-2030 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which was approved by the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission (MHTC) on July 9, 2025.

The MoDOT's FY 2026-2030 STIP incorporates Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Improvement Plans (TIPs) and includes the MHTC's certification that the statewide transportation planning process is being carried out in accordance with the requirements of 23 CFR 450.218 and 23 CFR 450.220. Based on federal review of the proposed STIP and all supporting documentation as well as analysis of statewide transportation planning practices, we hereby find that the FY 2026-2030 STIP substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C. 135, 49 U.S.C. 5304, and 23 CFR 450 Subpart B. Therefore, the FY 2026-2030 STIP and self-certification are approved.
