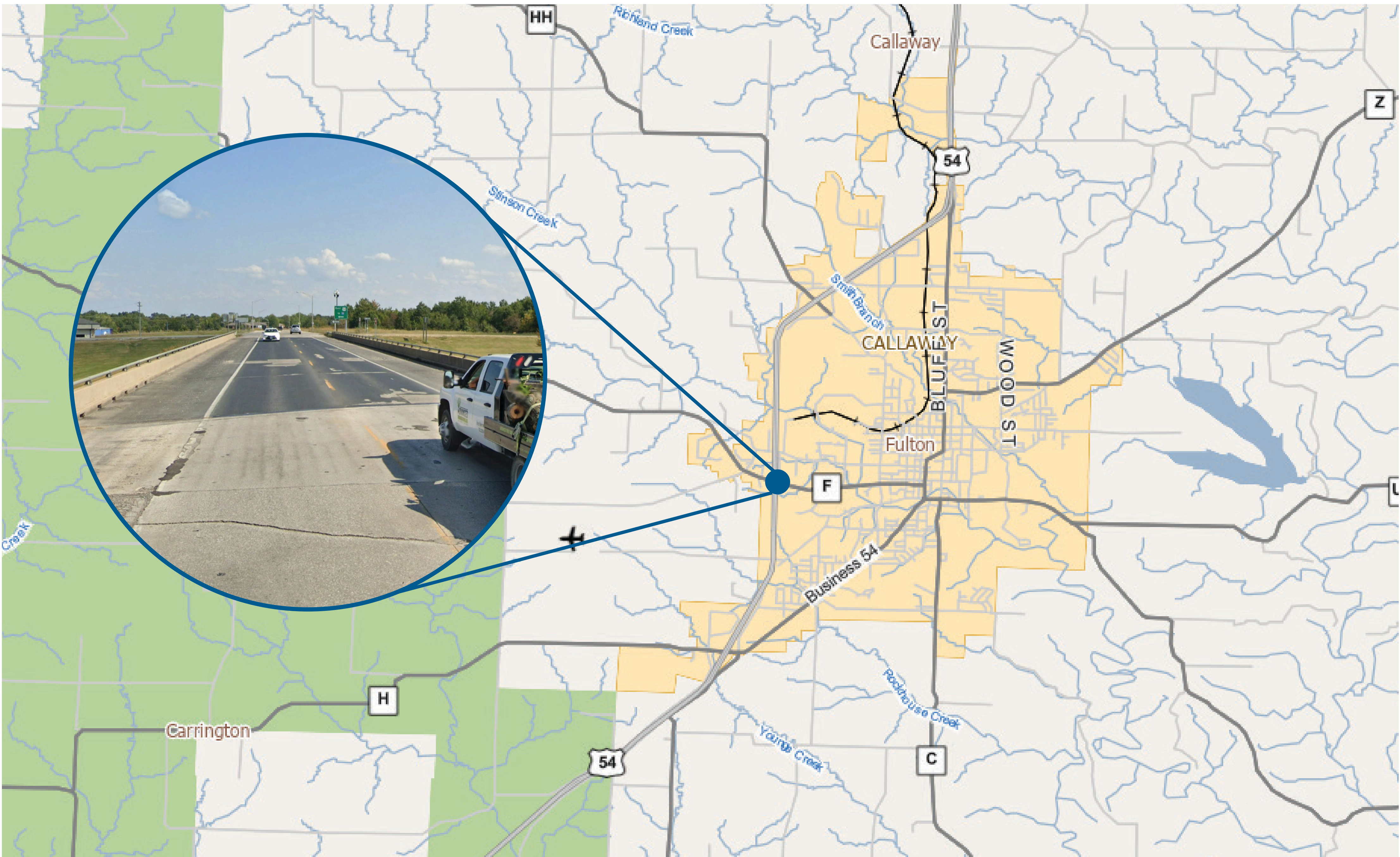


ROUTE F BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT OVER U.S. ROUTE 54 IN CALLAWAY COUNTY



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

Built in 1968, the bridge's supporting structure is in good condition, but the deck (driving surface) is deteriorating. The improvements include:

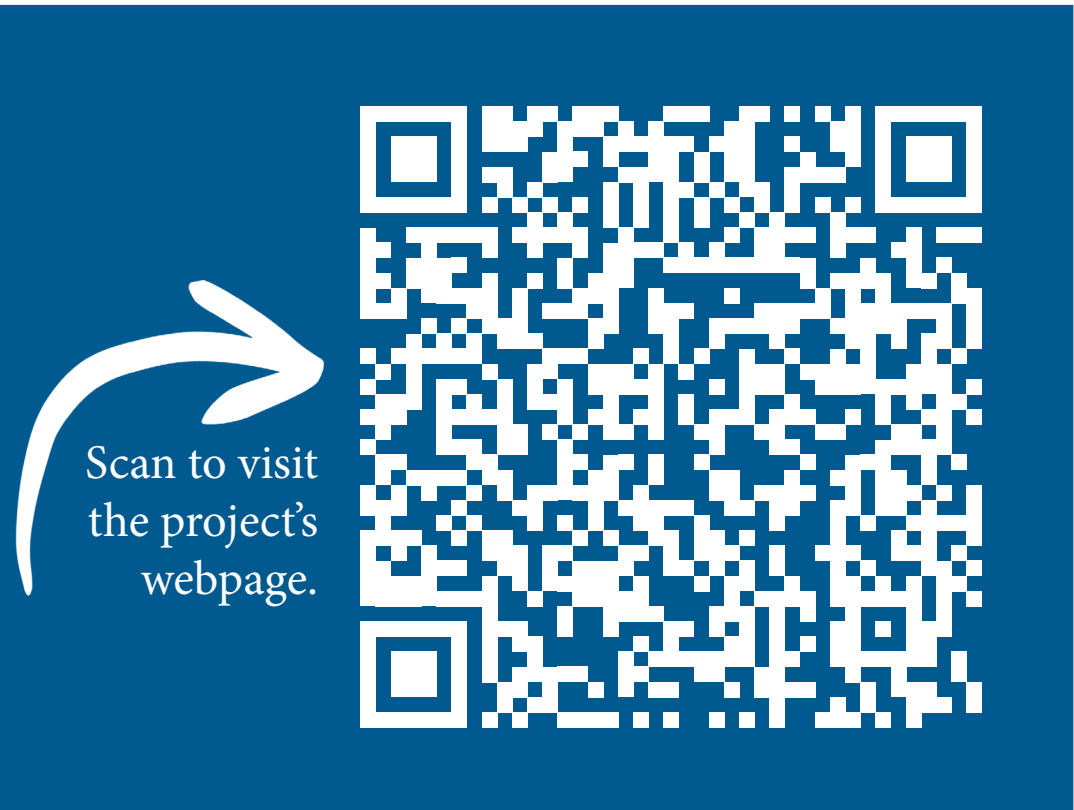
- New girders, which will raise the bridge to approximately 16 feet, 4 inches. This will increase the vertical clearance for vehicles traveling U.S. 54.
- New deck, the same width as the existing structure.
- Added beautification elements, including black fencing, stamped concrete, and city signs, in partnership with the City of Fulton.
- New sidewalk on the north side.
- New bridge barriers and new approach pavement.

Estimated Cost

- \$3.7 million including right-of-way, engineering, construction costs, and aesthetic enhancements.

Current Project Timeline

- **February 2027:** Contractors may submit competitive bids.
- **March 2027:** The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award a contract for project.
- **April 2027:** If awarded, the earliest the contractor may begin work.
- **End of 2027:** Anticipated completion of work.



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
