

NOTICE TO BID

The City of Kirksville will accept sealed bids for FEDERAL PROJECT NO. TAP-3700(213) **ROTARY PARK CONNECTIVITY PROJECT** (CITY PROJECT NO. PA-21-001), at the office of the City Clerk, 201 S. Franklin St., Kirksville, Missouri 63501-3580, until **3:00 p.m. Thursday, October 1, 2026**, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Copies of the Contract Documents required for bidding purposes may be obtained from the Engineering Department, 660.627.1225. ***A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 2026 in the 2nd floor conference room of City Hall, 201 South Franklin Street, Kirksville, MO. 63501. All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.*** Bid will be awarded to the *lowest, responsive, responsible bidder*; however, the City of Kirksville reserves the right to reject any and all bids. No bidder may withdraw bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the day of opening bids. A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The proposed work includes: **Traffic Control; Approximately 2,289 square feet of Removal & Disposal of Existing Improvements; 61 cubic yards Cut Embankment from City Stockpile; 387 cubic yards Fill Embankment; 9,111 square feet of 4" thick concrete sidewalk Macro Synthetic Fiber Reinforced over 4" rolled stone base; 471 square feet of ADA compliant Sidewalk Ramp Macro Synthetic Fiber Reinforced over 4" rolled stone base; 60 linear feet of Handrail; 63 linear feet 6" Semi-mountable Curb and Gutter; 309 square feet of 2' wide Square Curb and Gutter; 25 linear feet of 3' wide Square Curb and Gutter; 915 square feet of 8" thick concrete slab with 6" thick Type 5 base; 402 linear feet of 12" diameter Corrugated HDPE Storm Pipe; 3 each 12" diameter Flared End Section; 2 each 2'x3' Curb Inlet and Basin; 12,783 square feet of fertilizing, seeding, and mulching and related surface restoration including grading.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per section 102.2 of the 2026 Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, effective July 1, 2026. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

On this public works project no 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed. The DBE Goal for this project is **0%**.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects must provide a 10-hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

Bidders are also informed that the successful contractor awarded the contract shall comply with all requirements regarding licensing and testing per Chapter 12, Article I, Section 12-2

of the Kirksville Municipal Code, prior to issuance of Notice of Award.
