## BRIDGE REHABILITATION

Phelps County Kingshighway (Loop 44) Bridge Over I-44



### **PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS**

**Construction:** Expected summer 2025.

**Location:** Phelps County, west side of Rolla.

**Traffic impact:** Kingshighway at the bridge will be open to eastbound traffic during the 138 calendar day project.

Project estimate: \$1,005,000

**Average daily traffic:** 

Approximately 13,016 vehicles daily.

# PROJECT DETAILS

#### Why is MoDOT planning changes?

The driving surface of the bridge has deteriorated, and needs replaced, along with other minor bridge repairs. Also included in the plans is milling and replacing the pavement approaching each end of the bridge and replacing guardrail at two of the four corners of the bridge.

#### How will traffic be impacted?

The current plan is to keep the bridge open to eastbound traffic during construction. A detour will be signed for westbound traffic using Old Route 66(Route 63) to I-44 westbound back to Business Loop - 44. Route 63 will be used because Route E construction will likely be taking place at the same time.

#### What is the cost of the project?

The anticipated total construction and engineering cost for this project is \$1,005,000. This is subject to change.

## When is MoDOT planning to make the improvements?

At this time, the project is expected to be part of MoDOT's March 2025 letting when contractors may submit competitive bids.

Construction is anticipated to start in the summer of 2025; however, the exact schedule has not yet been determined.

As with all projects that are in the planning stage, these dates are subject to change.
