

MONITEAU COUNTY ROUTE T BRIDGE OVER BURRIS FORK CREEK REHABILITATION



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Planned Improvements

Built in 1960, the Route T bridge over Burris Fork Creek is in need a rehabilitation work to extend its useful life.

Planned improvements include:

- Removing one expansion joint and adjacent concrete.
- Repairing the substructure.
- Upgrading guardrail.

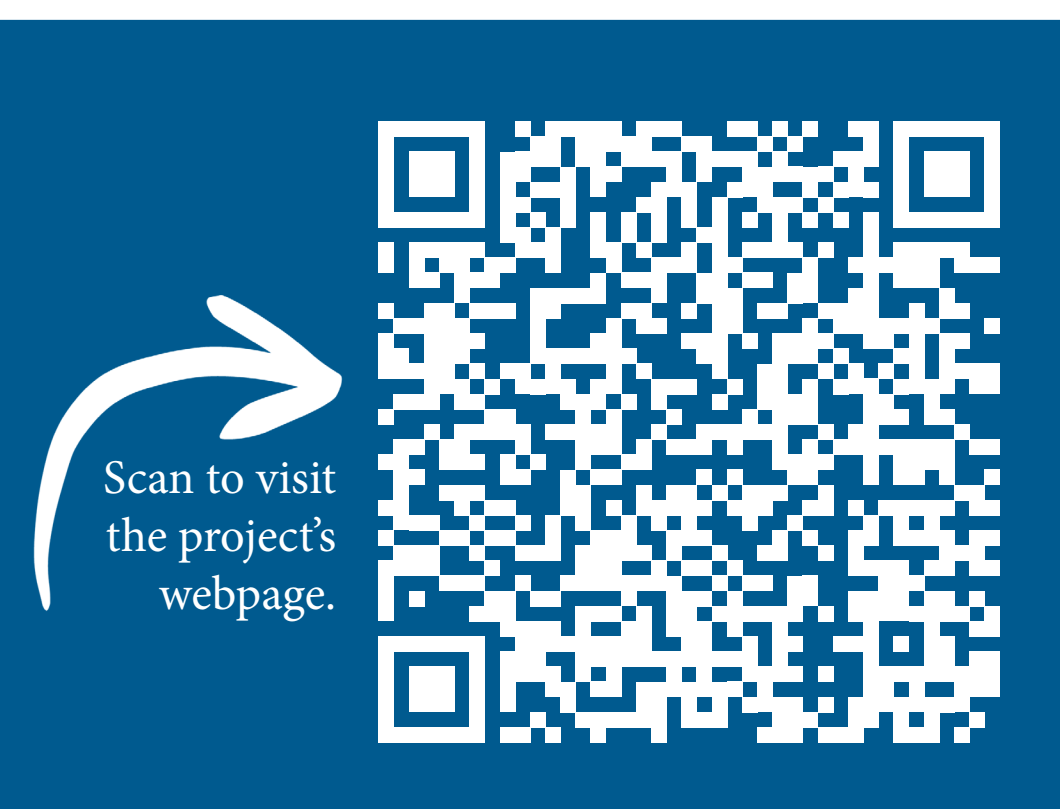
At 22 feet wide, there is not enough space to complete the work half at a time in a way that is safe for workers and motorists. As such, the preferred plan is to close the bridge during construction.

Estimated Cost

- \$160,000 including engineering and construction costs.

Current Project Timeline

- **October 2026:** Contractors may submit competitive bids.
- **November 2026:** The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission may award contract for work.
- **December 2026:** If awarded, the earliest the contractor may begin work.
- **End of 2027:** Anticipated completion of project.
