What is the purpose of the online meeting?

The purpose of the online meeting is to provide information and receive feedback on the plans to replace the bridge over Goodwin Hollow Creek on Route 64 in Laclede County.

Why is the work necessary?

This project has been scheduled to improve the safety at the bridge. This bridge was built in 1931 and, at 92 years old, the deck and the barriers are showing signs that the bridge is nearing the end of its life cycle. The bridge was built with narrow lanes compared to today's standards. In this project a new bridge will be constructed that is wider allowing more space between the barrier and the opposing traffic as well as improvements made to the curve east of the bridge.

How will traffic be affected?

During construction Route 64 will be closed 3-4 months. Signs will alert motorists of the closed road and a proposed detour route can be found in the project displays section. Additional coordination with Bennett Springs State Park is anticipated.

When will the work take place?

The work will be let in December 2023 and the construction will be completed by the end of the February 2025.

Will additional right of way be needed for this project?

Yes, 0.5 acres will need to be purchased for the improvements of this project.

What will the project cost?

The estimated total construction cost is approximately \$2.3 million. This includes the cost of the new bridge and the improvements/reconstruction of the roadway.
