

## Missouri Route 47 Improvements (Troy to Hawk Point)

Luture improvements to 6.7 centerline miles of Missouri Route 47 are on the horizon including the realignment of curves at select locations, the addition of paved shoulders, intersection improvements, and pavement resurfacing near Troy, from just west of the Route H/J intersection, to Hawk Point. Right of way and easements will be required for this project.

he project is currently scheduled to be awarded in early 2025. Construction is anticipated to be complete by winter 2025. The project is estimated to cost between \$18-20 million. Written and recorded oral statements and exhibits can be submitted at the

public hearing to be held October 4, 2023 from 4-6 p.m. at Cuivre River Electric Cooperative. People can also review materials and make comments on the project web page beginning October 4, 2023. All comments must be received by October 14. he environmental documentation prepared by MoDOT will be available for public inspection. Copies are also available at the office of Paula Gough, District Engineer, MoDOT Northeast District, 1711 Hwy 61 South in Hannibal.


