

One simple decision allows students to experience first-hand the dangers and consequences of distracted and impaired driving. First-person consequence videos, interactive quizzes, and advise from experts. A session consists of the PRACTICE DRIVE to gain experience. The Consequence videos will play based on the unique outcome of each drive. Students are free to repeat any of the drives to experience several different outcomes. This can be taken by an individual or be demonstrated in front of a large audience.

MoDOT staff must operate and attend to this simulator.

Time will be based on the number of Students, estimate 6-8 minutes per student.
