

Remote Brine Pump Switch



Description and Benefit

When top-loading Brine or Geomelt, wind often blows liquid onto the truck and windshield, creating a mess. Congestion from trucks moving between salt/mix and liquid loading increases the risk of accidents and repeatedly getting in and out of equipment to turn pumps on is both hazardous and time-consuming. This innovation uses a remote control to activate the pump from the loader cab, allowing operators to fill the bucket and dump liquid into the truck before the last material load. The result is a safer, cleaner, and more efficient operation.
