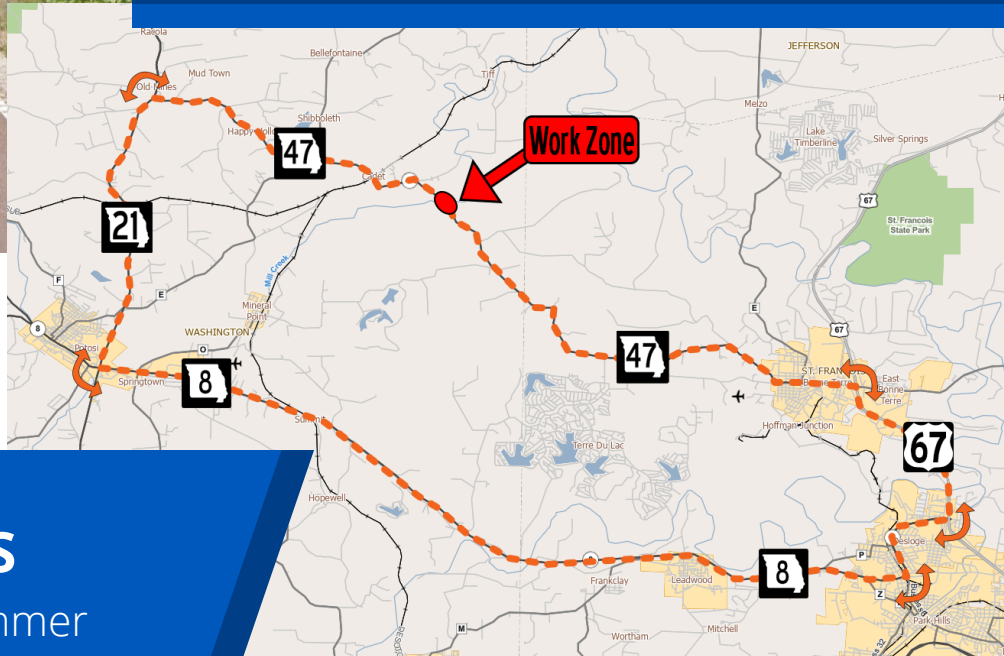

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Construction: Expected summer 2025.

Location: Washington County North of Potosi.

Traffic impact: Route 47 at the bridge will be closed up to 110 days.

Project estimate: \$930,000

Average daily traffic:

Approximately 3,043 vehicles daily.

PROJECT DETAILS

Why is MoDOT planning changes?

The Missouri Route 47 bridge over Mill Creek in Washington County, north of Potosi, was constructed in 1965, is narrow, and the deck is in poor condition. The rehabilitated bridge will be up to current standards with a wider bridge deck, upgraded concrete barriers, and new guardrail which will improve the drivability and safety for motorists.

How will traffic be impacted?

The contractor will close the bridge to all traffic through the completion of the project. A signed detour will be posted using Route 67, Route 8, and Route 21.

What is the cost of the project?

The anticipated total construction and engineering cost for this project is \$930,000. This is subject to change.

When is MoDOT planning to make the improvements?

At this time, the project is expected to be part of MoDOT's January 2025 letting when contractors may submit competitive bids.

Construction is anticipated to start in the summer of 2025; however, the exact schedule has not yet been determined.

As with all projects that are in the planning stage, these dates are subject to change.
