U.S. Route 60 (James River Freeway) at Glenstone Avenue Springfield

Project Facts:

- Add lane in Route 60 median in each direction between National Avenue & Route 65
- Consolidate Glenstone and Republic ramps to eastbound Route 60 at Harvard Avenue, remove existing northbound Glenstone Avenue-to-eastbound Route 60 on ramp near Nature Center Way
- Build roundabout on Glenstone Avenue at intersection with Nature Center Way/Republic Road
- Widen westbound Route 60 off ramp to Glenstone Avenue
- Replace deteriorating pavement on eastbound Route 60 west of Route 65
- All improvements can be made without needing additional property
- Estimated total project cost: \$22.3 million

Traffic Impacts:

- Nighttime lane closings on Route 60 and Glenstone Avenue
- Southbound Glenstone Avenue-to-eastbound Route
 60 ramp closed for up to 10 days
- Narrowed lanes and traffic shifts on Route 60 and on Glenstone Avenue
- Traffic shifts on Glenstone Avenue at Nature Center Way/Republic Road

- November 2020 Project awarded to construction contractor
- Winter/Spring 2021 Construction begins
