PROJECT FACT SHEET

What is the purpose of this project?

The purpose of this project is to enhance safety, address aging pavement and traffic signals, improve drainage, and improve lack of connectivity for pedestrians and all modes of transportation as well as replace the corridor's sidewalks, which no longer meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

Where is the project located?

The project is located along Route D (Page Ave.) between Pennsylvania Ave. and Skinker Pkwy./Kienlen Ave. in North St. Louis County.

What improvements will be made?

- Pavement resurfacing and new pavement markings/signage
- Upgraded sidewalks to meet ADA requirements
- Lane reduction to slow speeds and reduce crashes
- Three upgraded traffic signals to meet ADA standards
- Drainage system improvements
- New midblock crossings (*Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon RRFB see back side)

What is the timeline for the project?


- Fall/Winter 2023/2024: Community Meeting #1, online survey, walk audits, and focus groups
- Spring 2024: Conceptual Design, Conceptual Plans
- Fall 2024: Community Meeting #2 and design recommendations
- Fall 2025: Begin Construction

What is the cost of the project?

\$12.5 million
