ROUTE D SIDEWALK/ADA IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

This project will make improvements to the existing pedestrian facilities and sidewalks along 2.5 miles of Route D (Page Ave.) between Oak Ave. (just east of US-67) and Innerbelt Business Center Dr. (just west of I-170) in St. Louis County. In addition, the signalized intersection at Page Industrial Blvd. will be reconstructed. A separate project will be completed to address pavement improvements in the area.

What are the existing issues along Route D?

- Non-compliant Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps and entrances
- Narrow sidewalks
- Aging signals at Page Industrial Blvd.

What is the anticipated project schedule?

Preliminary Plans	October 2024
Right of Way Acquisition	Spring 2025
Contract Award	March 2026
Construction Begins	April 2026
Construction Complete	Summer 2027

Is MoDOT purchasing property from landowners?

MoDOT will need to purchase some property and/or obtain temporary easements in order to construct the additional sidewalks and ADA improvements. A Right of Way representative will be contacting affected landowners to begin the acquisition process.

How much will this project cost?

The cost of construction is estimated at \$3 million.
